Welcome to Tenuta di Artimino, an estate where timeless landscapes, authentic flavours, and Tuscan heritage come together to shape a collection of singular experiences.



Discover Tuscany on horseback with a serene two-hour ride through the rolling hills just beyond the Tenuta di Artimino estate. Nestled only 15 minutes from the hotel, a peaceful ranch welcomes riders of all levels to experience the beauty of the Tuscan countryside in an entirely new way.

Whether a beginner or seasoned equestrian, guests can enjoy a guided promenade tailored to both experience and curiosity. Led by expert instructors, each route offers a unique path through open landscapes, where the quiet of nature invites reflection and a slower pace. Children and adults alike are invited to join, with options ranging from tranquil countryside walks to personalised riding lessons.

Here, in this haven where horses thrive in generous, well-kept spaces, every moment is designed to reconnect with nature. Riders are matched thoughtfully with a horse suited to their ability, and all necessary safety equipment is provided. It's an experience that leaves guests feeling grounded, uplifted, and deeply in tune with the rhythms of the land.

A bottle of the estate's finest wine completes the experience, best enjoyed as the soft evening light drapes the hills in warm tones.

A JOURNEY THROUGH TUSCANY'S FINEST WINES

Explore the flavours and heritage of Tenuta di Artimino

Guests are invited to explore the character and craft of Tuscan winemaking with a guided tasting at the Wine Bar of Tenuta di Artimino. Located on the ground floor of the hotel, this intimate setting offers a welcoming space to sample a curated selection of estate-produced wines, each revealing the richness and diversity of the Carmignano region.

Led by a knowledgeable sommelier, the tasting includes labels such as Artumes, Vin Ruspo, Chianti Montalbano, and Poggilarca, accompanied by artisanal breadsticks to complement the experience. Guests can choose from three distinct tasting formats, each offering a deeper understanding of the winemaking process, whether through a classic introduction, a focus on Carmignano wines, or a vertical tasting that explores how time shapes the character of each vintage.

Available in Italian and English, the experience lasts between one to two hours and is available by reservation. A true celebration of place and tradition, it invites guests to slow down, savour the journey, and leave with a renewed appreciation for the land and its timeless flavours.



Standard Tasting – A guided tasting of four wines produced at the Artimino Estate (Spumante Brut, Chianti Montalbano, Marrucaia, and Artumes), accompanied by a platter of local delicacies.

Vertical Tasting – A guided tasting of five vintages of Carmignano Riserva, paired with a curated selection of cured meats and cheeses.









E-BIKE IN THE COUNTRY

Explore the countryside at your own pace—guided or self-led.

Discover the Tuscan countryside at your own rhythm with an e-bike ride through scenic hills, quiet lanes, and timeless landscapes. Whether riding solo or accompanied by an expert guide, this flexible experience offers the freedom to explore the beauty surrounding the estate with ease and comfort. Guests can choose between a self-guided route, perfect for those who wish to venture out independently or a guided tour led by a qualified professional who brings local insight and natural highlights to life. Options are available for half-day or full-day rides, with the convenience of having the bikes delivered directly to the estate. The routes can be adapted to suit different interests and levels, from gentle rides among vineyards to more adventurous paths along woodland trails and historic country roads.

E-bikes provide a smooth and effortless way to cover ground, allowing guests to focus on the experience itself, the scents of the landscape, the quiet rhythm of rural life, and the ever-changing views that open up around each bend. Stops along the way offer perfect moments for a photo, a breath of fresh air, or simply to take in the sense of space and stillness that defines this part of Tuscany.

Ideal for those looking to explore at a realxed pace, the e-bike experience blends gentle activity with the pleasure of being outdoors. Whether following a scenic trail or taking in lesser-known paths, guests enjoy a more personal connection with the land—unhurried, open-ended, and entirely their own.

CANTUCCI & VIN SANTO TASTING

A sweet encounter with Tuscany's biscuitmaking heritage.

Step into the sweet traditions of Tuscany with a Cantucci and Vin Santo tasting—a flavourful journey rooted in local heritage. Held inside the Piccolo Museo Bottega of the historic Biscottificio Antonio Mattei, this experience invites guests to discover the story behind one of the region's most beloved treats.

Located in the heart of Florence, the museum-shop offers a charming window into over 160 years of artisanal biscuit-making. Guests are guided through the history of the Mattei family and their famous almond biscuits, with original packaging, archival photographs, and the signature blue bags adding to the sense of timelessness. Tastings are served within the museum itself, where visitors can savour the golden, crunchy Cantucci—rich with almonds—paired with a glass of amber-hued Vin Santo, known for its notes of dried fruit, honey, and delicate nuttiness.

Available in Italian or English, this experience is more than a tasting—it's a quiet celebration of tradition, flavour, and the enduring craft of Tuscan baking. A simple, well-crafted encounter with Tuscany's enduring traditions.

What's included: A guided tasting of Antonio Mattei's classic almond biscuits (Cantucci) paired with a glass of Vin Santo, served inside the Piccolo Museo Bottega in Florence. An introduction to the history of the biscuit factory and its founding family,
